THE PHOTOGRAPHIC STUDIO

During this term students will no longer have Tuesday morning photography lectures but will be taught on an individual basis in the studio. Students will be able to choose either a morning session or an afternoon session that suits them from a timetable, bearing in mind the sessions of their fellow students.

Students are expected to complete a number of practical assignments in their own time, but will have an opportunity to work side by side a Professional Photographer during term 4. Students will receive a certificate upon completion.

YOU WILL NEED: A 35mm SLR Digital Camera With Manual Override Function. A Film Camera Is Required For The First Term Only, (Which May Be Borrowed). A Flash And Tripod Are Also Required, And A Laptop Capable Of Running The Relevant Software Programmes.
